1. The sSPT23 workshop is organized by G. Gaeta and S. Walcher, with the precious help of R. Vitolo and G. Gubbiotti; in particular, R. Vitolo – who is based in Lecce - provided contact with the hotel and will be able to help participants with “local” matters.
2. The main reason for this Newsletter is to remind you that we have a **deadline for proposing talks on January 10**. This applies for everybody who is not in the list on our website (thus also for people who were invited but could not confirm participation by the end of November).
3. Acceptation of proposed talks will be communicated as soon as possible, and anyway not later than January 25; thus in time to meet the Hotel deadline for reservations.
4. I would like to thank those who already sent their registration form and talk proposal. It appears we will have more proposals than expected; this also means we could have more proposed talks than we can accommodate in the workshop format, so we might be forced to make a selection also among scientifically sound and interesting proposals.
5. Please note that all proposals received so far have been acknowledged; so if you sent a proposal but did not receive an acknowledgement, something went wrong (and please submit again the form & the talk proposal). Most probably proposals received near the deadline will be acknowledged with some days’ delay.
6. Invited speakers (that is, those on the list on our web page) are not required to send a title and abstract at this time. But doing so (retaining of course the right to change title later on), as some of you have already done, would be an act of courtesy to other participants, in that when we announce the contributed talks (end of January) it would be nice to have also an overall picture of what all the talks are going to be.
7. A **reservation form** is now posted on our web page. As mentioned above, the Hotel is keeping all of their rooms reserved for SPT participants until the end of January; after this they could give rooms to the general public (I hope this may be slightly postponed).
8. The hotel has about 50 rooms; these will be given on a “first come first served” basis also for what concerns the standard/superior choice. The Hotel also handles a few mini-flats; contact them for details. Other details about contacting the Hotel etc are given in

newsletter #2. You are of course free to lodge elsewhere if you wish so; in this case you have to make your own arrangements.

9. Pre-registration has no deadline for those not wishing to propose a talk. The list of pre-registered participants will be made public at some point (if for some reason you want your name not to appear, please state this clearly in the form).
10. Please feel free to circulate information about sSPT2023 among your contacts and collaborators.
